

**PROPOSED TRIAL BOREHOLE AT PENN,
WOLVERHAMPTON, STAFFORDSHIRE.**

NOTICE is hereby given that an application has been made by the National Coal Board to the High Court of Justice, Chancery Division (1952 N. No. 969) seeking an Order conferring upon the applicants the right to search and bore for coal at a point situate upon an undeveloped piece of land at Penn in the borough of Wolverhampton upon such terms and subject to such conditions and for such period as the Court shall think fit, the object of such application being to enable the applicants to sink a trial borehole at the said point in order to discover whether the existing colliery workings of the Baggeridge Colliery can effectively be extended in a northerly direction. And notice is also hereby given that copies of the Originating Summons and of an Affidavit of John Dando filed on 10th June 1952 in support thereof and of the exhibits thereto (including a plan showing the site of the said proposed borehole) and an Order dated 20th June 1952 directing (inter alia) these notices may be inspected at any time during the hours of 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays (except Saturdays) and 10 a.m. to noon on Saturdays at the Offices of the applicants at Hobart House, 36-42 Grosvenor Place, London, S.W.1 and Himley Hall, Dudley, Worcestershire, and copies thereof or extracts therefrom may be taken by any person or Corporation interested.

And notice is also hereby given that every person or Corporation desiring to object and wishing to be heard in opposition to the application must do so by giving notice in writing of such objection addressed to Mr. R. - (1) the name and address of the objector.
- (2) how such objector is interested.
- (3) particulars of any property in respect of which any such interest arises and of the estate or interest of the objector in question in such property.
- (4) the grounds of such objection.
