DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 85(3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Statutory Instruments 1952 No. 1571.

The Prohibition of Landing of Animals and Hay and Straw from the Channel Islands (Revocation) Order, 1952.

(Made 22nd August, 1952.)

This Order revokes, as from 1st September, 1952, the Prohibition of Landing of Animals and Hay and Straw from the Channel Islands Order, 1952.

Statutory Instruments 1952 No. 1581.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)

Special Order No. 135, 1952.

(Made 25th August, 1952.)

1. Extends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Hamsey, Lewes, Sussex, declared by Special Order No. 133, 1952, so as to include an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 10 miles of Upper Beeding, Steyning, Sussex.

2. Contracts, as from 28th August, 1952, the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Holywood, Dumfries, declared by Special Order No. 121, 1952, and amended by Special Orders Nos. 122, 127 and 129, 1952, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Dumfries.

3. Releases such contracted Infected Area from restrictions on 4th September, 1952.

The High Commissioner for India has, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Commonwealth Relations, appointed Mr. G. C. Anson, Assistant-Superintendent, Mercantile Marine Office, Hull, to superintend the transfer of Lascars or other persons and to grant the Certificate required under Section 125 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894 (57 and 58 Vic. Cap. 60).

The fee to be paid for every Lascar or other person in respect of whom such Certificate is applied for, is limited to three shillings each and in no case is the total amount of fees in respect of one crew to exceed five pounds.
