Swinton New Road.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as extended by section 14 of the Special Roads Act, 1949, the effect of which is that a length of new road which he proposes to construct in the Borough of Swinton and Pendlebury in the County of Lancaster will become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as amended by the Special Roads Act, 1949, or on the ground that any requirement of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as so amended has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the 16th day of September, 1952, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

SPECIAL ROADS ACT, 1949.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 14 of the Special Roads Act, 1949, the effect of which is to provide for the regrading of that length of the road leading to Southorpe in the Rural District of Peterborough in the County of the Soke of Peterborough which extends north-westwards for a distance of approximately 60 yards from its junction with the Birmingham—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road.
