

## Statutory Instruments 1953 No. 253.

*The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 13, 1953.*

(Made 18th February, 1953.)

1. Contracts, as from 23rd February, 1953, the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Llanvair Kilgeddin, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire, declared by Special Order No. 12, 1953, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Llanvair Kilgeddin.

2. Extends, as from 23rd February, 1953, the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Caerau, Maesteg, Glamorgan, declared by Special Order No. 12, 1953, so as to include the County Borough of Newport and certain parishes in the County of Monmouth.

3. Releases the contracted Infected Area around Llanvair Kilgeddin, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire, from restrictions on 2nd March, 1953.
