The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that the following Regulations are published with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of H.M. Treasury, viz.:-

REGULATIONS FOR RECRUITMENT FROM ESTABLISHED CLERICAL OFFICERS FOR THE EXECUTIVE CLASSES (GENERAL AND DEPARTMENTAL) OF THE HOME CIVIL SERVICE.

1. Age.

Candidates must be at least 21 and under 28 years of age on 1st August, 1953.

Provided that the Commissioners may, at their discretion, waive the maximum age limit in favour of a candidate who, although eligible, was prevented from attending an earlier Limited Competition for the Executive Classes as a result of having been recalled from the Reserve for a period of service or training with H.M. Forces.
