THE WATER ACT, 1945.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen
and Burgesses of the Borough of Stafford (hereinafter
called "the Corporation") acting as statutory water
undertakers for the said Borough, intend to apply to
the Minister of Housing and Local Government
(hereinafter called "the Minister") to make an Order
under Section 10 (1) of the Water Act, 1945, to vary
the limits of supply of the Corporation and affecting
the following areas:—

Marston in the said Rural District of Stafford in
the said County of Stafford comprising an area of
approximately 623 acres or thereabouts, all which
said areas Firstly, Secondly and Thirdly described
are shown coloured pink on the map (hereinafter
called "the said map") deposited in the offices of
the Corporation.

Fourthly an area consisting of part of the parishes
of Seighford and Castle Church in the said Rural
District of Stafford in the said County of Stafford
comprising approximately 3,060 acres or thereabouts
and shown coloured green on the said map.

Minister and of the said Map may be inspected at
the offices of the Town Clerk, Borough Hall, Stafford,
by any person free of charge, at all reasonable hours
during a period of twenty-eight days from the 18th
day of July, 1953.
