The Hartley Wintney Rural District (Eversley No. 1) Diversion Order, 1953.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made the 18th day of November, 1953, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land in the Parish of Eversley. The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way at Eversley commencing in the north-eastern corner of O.S. Parcel No. 5, and following an irregular course in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 1,250 feet close to the Blackwater River to the private drive of The Mill House and thence in a south-westerly direction along the said drive for a distance of approximately 78 feet to New Mill Road—so that it follows the eastern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 5 in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 364 feet and thence in a north-westerly direction through the coppice strip (O.S. Notice of any such appeal should be given in writing to The Clerk of the Peace, The Castle, Winchester, within 28 days of the publication of this notice and should specify the land to which the application relates, the grounds upon which the application is made and the name of the Surveying Authority (i.e. the Hampshire County Council), and the applicant should serve a copy of such notice upon every other person appearing to the applicant to be the owner, lessee or occupier of the said land or of any other land specified in the application with regard to which the Court may make a declaration, and upon the Surveying Authority. Applicants should consult the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952 (S.I. 1952 No. 559) and section 29 to 31 of the above Act.
