

NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

NOTICE is hereby given that the Durham County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statements prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way within the area of the said Council by:—

1. the deletion of the paths described in the First Schedule hereto;
2. the addition of the paths described in the Second Schedule hereto;
3. the alteration of the status of the paths described in the Third Schedule hereto; and
4. the alteration of the line of the paths described in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

NOTICE is hereby further given that these modifications are shown on a map which has been deposited at the offices of the County Surveyor, Aykley Heads, Durham, where it may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours. A copy of so much of this map as relates to each individual borough, urban and rural district council area in the County affected by these determinations has also been deposited at the offices of each of the borough, urban and rural district councils whose area it covers, where it may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours.

NOTICE is hereby further given that any representation or objection with respect to these determinations shall be made in writing addressed to the undersigned before the 23rd day of January, 1954, and shall state the grounds on which it is made.
