COUNTY BOROUGH OF BOLTON.

BOLTON CORPORATION ACT, 1949.

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 43 of the Bolton Corporation Act, 1949, the Corporation have made an Order entitled the Bolton (Town Centre) Smokeless Zone Order, 1953, which is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The general effect of the Order is to prohibit the emission of smoke from any premises in the area described in the Schedule set out below with the exception of the premises known as the Bee Hive Steel Foundry, Bark Street, Bolton, and part of the premises known as the Bark Street Tannery, Bolton.

Lessees or tenants incurring expense on executing works etc. to comply with the Order may agree with the owner of their premises to make reasonable variations in their terms of lease or tenancy and in the event of disagreement with the owner may apply to the County Court for an Order making such variations.

The Order does not apply to smoke emitted from railway locomotives.

A copy of the Order, and of the plan referred to therein may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office during office hours.

Notice is hereby given that within the period of 28 days after the 6th January, 1954, any person may object to the confirmation of the Order by giving notice in writing to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, and sending a copy of such notice to the undersigned.
