On the 16th December, 1953, Senior Technician Evans was flying in Valetta VX.575 when it crashed and burst into flames near Qormi Village. When the captain checked his crew on leaving the when the capital checket his crew on leaving the aircraft the signaller was unaccounted for. Senior Technician Evans climbed on to the nose of the burning fuselage and broke his way in through the perspex of the pilot's cockpit. Despite the fact that the aircraft was burning furiously and was full of smoke, Senior Technician Evans remained in the fuselage looking for the signaller until he was ordered by the captain to leave. He was only was ordered by the captain to leave. He was only just clear of the wreckage when the tanks exploded and the aircraft blew up. In re-entering the burning aircraft to look for his fellow non-commissioned officer, Senior Technician Evans showed complete disregard for his own safety and, had it not been for the fact that the captain ordered him out of the aircraft, he would probably have remained to the end. Unknown to the captain and to Senior Technician Evans, the signaller, who was severely burned, had escaped and had been taken away by some Maltese labourers before they themselves left some Maltese labourers before they themselves left the aircraft.
