LONDON PASSENGER TRANSPORT ACT, 1933.

LONDON PASSENGER TRANSPORT ACT, 1933.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation has made "The London Traffic (Prohibition of Waiting) (Woodbridge, Guildford) Regulations, 1954" (S.I. 1954 No. 882), coming into operation on the 16th day of July, 1954, which prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on either of the following lengths of road:—

1. London—Portsmouth Trunk Road (Route A.3): from the eastern end of the bridge over the River Wey at Woodbridge, Guildford, eastwards for 205 yards, with the exception of the service road lying on the north side of the main carriageway.

2. Woodbridge Road (Route A.321): from the junction with London—Portsmouth Trunk Road (Route A.3) at Woodbridge, Guildford, southwards

for 68 yards. Exemptions will be made to allow loading and unloading and picking up and setting down passengers, etc.
