PROHIBITED RIGHT TURNS—HAMMERSMITH.

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation proposes, in exercise of his powers under the London Traffic Act, 1924, s. 10, as amended by the London Passenger Transport Act, 1933, s. 63, to make Regulations to prohibit right turns from Holland Park Avenue into Norland Road and from Richmond Way into Uxbridge Road, Hammersmith.
