*March East Internal Drainage District.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has now confirmed the Order made on the 23rd August, 1954, confirming the Scheme submitted by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board (now superseded by the Great Ouse River Board) under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, making provision for the following matters:—

- (1) The constitution of the March East Internal Drainage District and of the Drainage Board thereof.
- (2) The abolition of the March First Drainage District and the March Second Drainage District and of the Commissioners thereof.
- (3) The making of alterations in certain Local Acts and Schemes.
- (4) Matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

The Scheme affects lands in the Urban District of March, the Rural Districts of North Witchford and Wisbech, and the Parishes of Wimbington and Upwell.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
