The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 23rd day of March, 1955, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—
"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for constituting a new parish to be taken out of the parishes of Hangleton; Saint Leonard, Aldrington; and Portslade; in the diocese of Chichester.

"SCHEME.

"Whereas we, the Church Commissioners, are satisfied that the spiritual interests of the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed would be best served by constituting it a new parish:

"And whereas we are satisfied that a suitable endowment therefor will be provided:

"And whereas there is within the said area a consecrated church known as Saint Helen, Hangleton, which has been approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be the parish church of the new parish and of which the patronage belongs to the Bishop of Chichester by virtue of an agreement in writing dated the 20th December, 1954, and made pursuant to section 9 of the New Parishes Measure, 1943:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend George, Bishop of Chichester (in testimony whereof he has set his hand and affixed his episcopal seal to this Scheme), we, the said Church Commissioners, do humbly recommend and propose as follows, that is to say:—

"1. Constitution: "(a) As from the day of the date of the publica-tion in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme, the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed shall be a

new parish.

"(b) The Church of Saint Helen, Hangleton, aforesaid shall be the parish church of the parish.

"(c) The name of the parish shall be 'the Parish

of Hangleton'.

"2. Archdeaconry and Rural Deanery:
"The parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of Lewes and in the rural deanery of Hove.

#### "THE SCHEDULE.

"The area comprising:—
"(1) The whole of the parish of Hangleton (coloured pink on the map annexed hereto),
"(2) all that part of the parish of Saint Leonard, Aldrington, (coloured green on the map annexed hereto) which is bounded on the north-west by the

parishes of Portslade and Hangleton on the north by the parish of Hangleton and on the remaining by the parish of Hangleton and on the remaining sides by an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Bishop Hannington Memorial Church, Hove, from the parish of Saint Leonard, Aldrington, at a point in the middle of Hangleton Road and continuing thence southwards along the last mentioned boundary to a point opposite to the eastern end of the wall or fence forming the southern boundary of the Knoll County Infants' School, and continuing thence westwards to and along the last mentioned wall or fence to the fall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the house or premises mentioned wall or fence to the fall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the house or premises known as No. 147 Stapley Road and continuing thence southwards along the last mentioned wall or fence and in continuation thereof along the walls or fences forming the rear boundaries of the houses or premises situated on the eastern side of Stapley Road to the south-western end of the wall or fence forming the rear boundary of the house or premises known as No. 1 Stapley Road and continuing thence southwestwards along the southeastern boundary of the house or premises known as No. 301 Old Shoreham Road to its end and in a straight line in continuation thereof to a point in the middle of the last mentioned road and continuing thence northeastwards along the middle of Old Shoreham Road to a point opposite the northern end of the wall or fence forming the

and continuing thence northeastwards along the middle of Old Shoreham Road to a point opposite the northern end of the wall or fence forming the western boundary of Hove Cemetery and continuing thence southwards to and along the last mentioned boundary to its end and in a straight line in continuation thereof to a point in the middle of Brighton and Portsmouth Main railway line of British Railways (Southern Region) and continuing thence westwards along the middle of the last mentioned railway line to the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Leonard, Aldrington, from the parish of Portslade.

"(3) All that part of the parish of Portslade (coloured mauve on the map annexed hereto) which is bounded on the north by the parish of Hangleton on the southeast by the parish of Saint Leonard, Aldrington, on the south by the parish of Saint Andrew, Portslade by Sea, and on the remaining side by an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Hangleton from the parish of Portslade opposite the northern end of the wall or fence forming the western boundary of the house or premises known as No. 259 Old Shoreham Road and continuing thence southwards to and along the last mentioned wall or fence, thereby crossing Old Shoreham Road and in a straight line in continuation thereof along the walls or fences forming the western boundaries of the houses or premises known as Nos. 7 to 4 The Gardens and in a straight line in continuation thereof to the north-eastern boundary of the factory premises known as the Fryco Mineral Water Factory and continuing thence southwestwards along the last
