"4. Ships' Fighting Proficiency Fund. The Ships' Gunnery Proficiency Fund and the Ships' Torpedo Proficiency Fund, governed by Orders in Council of 29th February, 1908, 13th August, 1920, 28th November, 1923, 6th June, 1935, and 25th April, 1941, are abolished, and from 1st July, 1951, are replaced by the Ships' Fighting Proficiency Fund. The new fund will take over any balance left in the Gunnery Proficiency Fund and the Torpedo Proficiency Fund, and be maintained by an annual capitation rate of 1s. 6d. reckoned upon the number of ratings allowed in each ship.

"Prizes and Trophies will be awarded from the Fund

"Prizes and Trophies will be awarded from the Fund to any rating of any branch of the Royal Navy or any other rank of the Army or Royal Air Force when embarked in Her Majesty's Ships, who, in performance of his duties contributes in a marked way to the fighting efficiency of the ship, or whose work under action conditions is considered by the Commanding Officer to deserve recognition of that kind. Awards will be confined

to those personnel serving in seagoing ships except that an Air Group allocated to a Carrier is considered seagoing notwithstanding that it may be disembarked for some period to a Naval Air Station.

"SCHEDULE XIII—RE-ENGAGEMENT BOUNTY"
The re-engagement Bounty of £100 approved by Order in Council of 30th January, 1952, and which should have ceased on 31st December, 1952, will continue to be paid to ratings, Royal Navy and other ranks Royal Marine, who were serving on 1st September, 1950, and who without a break in service re-engage to complete time for pension on or after that date.

"It will also be payable to those personnel who having had no previous service in any of the armed forces of the Crown, enter the Royal Navy or Royal Marines for the first time after 1st September, 1950, and without a break in service re-engage or undertake to re-engage to complete time for pension when eligible to do so.
