THE Smallburgh Rural District Council acting in their capacity as Coast Protection Authority hereby give notice under subsection (1) of section 5 of the Coast Protection Act, 1949, that they propose to carry out coast protection work as described herein at Happisburgh.

The work will consist of lateral revetment parallel to the cliff 2000 feet long of standard groyne construction extending from 100 feet North of the old Lifeboat Station to a point 300 feet South of the last cliff bungalows at Beach Road and include proper access way over the same at the Lifeboat roadway, together with three standard permeable steel groynes.
