The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in accordance with the provisions of the Northern Ireland Land Act, 1925 (15 and 16 Geo. V., c. 34) and of the Northern Ireland Land (Finance) Rules, 1926, made thereunder the within-mentioned Bonds amounting to £61,605 say, sixty-one thousand six hundred and five pounds, were

this day drawn for payment.

The Bonds will be paid off at par on or after the 1st November, 1955, at the Bank of England, London, unless registered in the Books of the Bank of Ireland, Belfast, in which case the Bonds will be redeemed at the Bank of Ireland, Belfast. Interest on the Bonds will cease from 1st November, 1955.

N.B.—Bonds, accompanied by a request signed by all the Registered Holders for transmission of the Warrant for the Redemption money, must be presented at the Chief Accountant's Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, E.C.2, unless registered in the Books of the Bank of Ireland, Belfast, in which case the Bonds must be presented at the Bank of Ireland, Belfast.
