

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES AND FOOD
PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice, in pursuance of the above-named Regulations, that he hereby recognises the official certificate of which particulars are given in the schedule hereto as showing (a) that the meat to which it relates or the meat from which the meat product to which it relates was prepared was derived from animals inspected ante and post mortem and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister and (b) that all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to public health were taken in the dressing or preparing and packing of the meat or meat product.

The certificate being in the form of a label, recognition will apply only if the label is securely affixed to the meat or the container or package containing the meat or meat product and the label has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an official certificate.

The label hereby recognised is in substitution for the label having on it the design reproduced in part XX of the schedule to the notice published in the London Gazette of the 6th August, 1937, which is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

YUGOSLAVIA

A label having on it a design in the form set out below, the words "Yugoslavia", "No." and "Veterinary Inspected" being printed in red within a black outline.



The certificate will be completed by the insertion of the number of the establishment, and by the impression of the veterinary officer's seal.
