#### HORNCHURCH URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL.

*The Hornchurch Urban District (Hubbards Chase) Diversion Order, 1954.*

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 14th day of September, 1955, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to divert the public right of way which runs from Hubbards Chase to the Southend Arterial Road in a north easterly direction over field No. O.S.228, to run along the western and northern boundaries of the said field to Southend Arterial Road. The diversion takes effect on the 13th day of October, 1955, and commencing on that date the existing way will cease to be a public right of way.
