

NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

NOTICE is hereby given that the Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statement prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to rights of way within the area of the said Council by:—

- (1) the deletion of the paths described in the First Schedule hereto;
- (2) the addition of the paths described in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) the alteration of the status of the paths described in the Third Schedule hereto; and
- (4) the alteration of the line of the paths described in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

Notice is hereby further given that these modifications, so far as they relate to the County Districts affected, are shown on maps and described in lists deposited at the under-mentioned addresses where they may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours from the fourteenth day of October, 1955, to the twelfth day of November, 1955, both dates inclusive.
