NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 6th day of October, 1955, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land situate in the following Parish.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way running from its junction with Parkgate Road (CX.59) in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 210 feet (Point B on map) to a line running from its junction with Parkgate Road (CX.59) (Point C on map) in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 170 feet to Point B on the map.
