The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to approve the following award for gallant and distinguished services in Malaya:—

*Distinguished Conduct Medal.*

21134202 Sergeant RAMSUR RAI, 6th Gurkha Rifles.  
 On the 18th October, 1955, Sergeant RAMSUR RAI was leading a routine patrol in IPOH District of Malaya. Towards the end of a heavy day in unpleasant weather fresh tracks were found. After skilful movement and careful reconnaissance an occupied camp for ten Communist Terrorists was discovered. Sergeant RAMSUR crawled to within a short distance of the camp and gained observation less than twenty yards from a terrorist sentry. The terrorists were seen to be alert with their weapons in their hands. Sending his runner back for a Bren Gun Sergeant RAMSUR remained alone in this position for nearly an hour.

When the gun arrived Sergeant RAMSUR, although outnumbered by three to one, stood up and called upon the terrorists to surrender. They opened fire which was vigorously returned with the result that two were killed and the remainder fled when Sergeant RAMSUR's party of three charged into the camp. Others were wounded and followed up until darkness intervened. The next morning a third dead terrorist was seen and several weapons were found.

In this operation Sergeant RAMSUR RAI showed skill, courage and determination of the highest order. Its success was due entirely to him.
