DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Scotland acting jointly have made the following Order:—

Statutory Instruments 1956 No. 101.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected and Controlled Areas Restrictions) (Amendment) Order, 1956 (Made 19th January, 1956).

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st March, 1956, abolishes the need for counter-signature of licences authorising the movement of

animals into and within Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected and Controlled Areas. It also prohibits the holding of point-to-point meetings in Infected Areas, and permits greyhound racing to take place in Infected Areas on tracks licensed under the Betting and Lotteries Act, 1934.

NATIONAL PARKS COMMISSION.

The Quantock Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Designation) Order, 1956.
