Notice of Determination to Modify Particulars Contained in the Draft Rights of Way Map for South Berks.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statement prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way within the southern area of the County of Berks (comprising the Borough of Newbury and the Rural Districts of Hungerford, Newbury and Bradfield), by the deletion of the public paths or roads used as public paths described in the First Schedule hereto, and by the addition of the public rights of way described in the Second Schedule hereto.

A map showing the effect of these modifications has been deposited and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at the Shire Hall, Reading, and the Offices of the Hungerford Rural District Council, The Priory, Hungerford, and also at the Newbury Borough Library, Cheap Street, Newbury, where they may be seen free of charge between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on weekdays except Wednesday (10 a.m. and 1 p.m.).

In addition the relevant sections of the Draft Map as originally deposited, together with particulars of all modifications within their area, may be seen at the offices of the aforementioned Borough and Rural District Councils and at an address in each Parish to be ascertained from the Parish Chairman or Clerk.

Any representation or objection with respect to these determinations shall be made in writing addressed to the undersigned before the 10th day of March, 1956.
