The Military Medal

22447666 Sergeant (acting) Gordon Albert Roger WESTALL, Royal Hampshire Regiment.

On 12th January, 1956, the platoon of which Sergeant WESTALL was platoon sergeant was standof men were seen moving some two hundred yards away. The platoon commander with Sergeant Westall and three others moved forward to investigate the service of the service o tigate. After following fresh tracks three terrorists

tigate. After following fresh tracks three terrorists were seen whereupon the platoon commander ran towards them only to be shot and killed by a fourth terrorist whose presence had not been detected. Sergeant Westall at once assumed command leading his men in the face of heavy terrorists fire from amongst the trees. He himself wounded two terrorists in succession. He then closed with a terrorist, who had wounded one of the platoon, and put him out of action at point blank range. Two terrorists only escaped. The pursuit was eventually called off in the late evening due to failing light and heavy rain.

The success of this action, which resulted in the death of a notorious terrorist murderer, was entirely

death of a notorious terrorist murderer, was entirely due to Sergeant WESTALL'S leadership, personal bravery, dash and good shooting.
