STEVENAGE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

Stevenage New Town Compulsory Purchase Order No. 2, 1956.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL.

IN THE RURAL DISTRICT OF CHELTENHAM.

Parish of Ashchurch.

Map No. 7.—Add footpath from AAS.22 proceeding south west to join County road A.438 near Ashchurch Railway Bridge.

Map No. 7.—Realign Footpath AAS.22 at a point slightly north of where it is shown to cross the railway at Ashchurch such that it goes over the footbridge and not the level crossing.

Map No. 7.—Delete footpath AAS.42 from Route A.438, east to Route 3/89 near Pamington.

Maps Nos. 5 and 7.—Delete footpath AAS.49 from footpath AAS.47, south to footpath ATE.1 at the Parish boundary south east of Aston-on-Carrant.

Parish of Badgeworth.

Map No. 38.—Add footpath near the "Oddfellow's Arms" from Route A.46 south east to the Bentham road, Route 3/195.

Map No. 39.—Continue Coberly path CRB. ACO.12 in a south westerly direction to join the County Road near the Sandpits, Crickley Hill.
