*The Gower Rural (Beaufort Drive, Kittle, Footpath)
Diversion Order, 1957.*

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 3rd day of April, 1957, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land situate in the Parish of Pennard in the County of Glamorgan.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way running from Kittlehill Lane in a north-westerly direction across enclosure numbered 72 on the Ordnance Survey Map for the said Parish of Pennard for a distance of 280 feet or thereabouts to a line running from Kittlehill Lane (110 feet or thereabouts north of the point of entry of the existing path) through the said enclosure numbered 72 for a distance of 85 feet or thereabouts to a stile and thence for a distance of 130 feet or thereabouts to the point where it joins that part of the existing path which is not the subject of this Order.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Council Offices, 7-8, Uplands Crescent, Swansea, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.

Compensation for depreciation or damage in consequence of the coming into operation of this Order is payable in accordance with section 46 of the above Act, to which reference should be made.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Under Secretary, Welsh Office, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Cathays Park, Cardiff, before the 27th day of May, 1957, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
