Treasury Chambers, S.W.1.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under section 9 of the Finance Act, 1932, and section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, viz. :—

The Import Duties (Drawback) (No. 11) Order, 1957, which increases from 2s. 10d. to 3s. 4d. per lb. the rate of drawback allowable in respect of Customs duty paid on certain coated aluminium foil used in the manufacture of certain exported metallic yarn.

The Order comes into operation on the 20th June, 1957, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1957, No. 1011.
