Notice of submission of Preliminary Draft Regulations entitled

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE (CHILD'S SPECIAL ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS, 1957.

In accordance with section 77 of the National Insurance Act, 1946, the National Insurance Advisory Committee give notice that they have received from the Joint Authority (comprising the Minister of Pensions and National Insurance and the Minister of Labour and National Insurance for Northern Ireland) for consideration and report thereon the preliminary draft of regulations entitled the National Insurance (Child's Special Allowance) Regulations, 1957.

A short explanatory note on these regulations is appended to this notice.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

These Regulations prescribe for the purposes of section 5 (2) (c) of the National Insurance Act, 1957, five shillings as the lowest weekly sum a former husband must have been contributing before his death to the support of a child, so as to enable a woman, whose marriage has been terminated by divorce, to be entitled to a child's special allowance.

Provision is also made to apply certain existing regulations to child's special allowance.

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND CIVIL AVIATION.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under s. 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, authorising the stopping up of a length of the footpath leading from Dersingham to the Dersingham—Anmer Road at Dersingham, Norfolk, and requiring the provision of a new footpath.

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1952.

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952 and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, to wit—fourteen cases, marked R.N.C./L/1-14, containing amusement machines imported in s.s. "Breconshire" on 20th September, 1956, at King George V Dock, London, have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that the said goods were imported

contrary to the prohibition for the time being in force with respect thereto by virtue of the Import of Goods (Control) Order, 1954.

Whereby and by force of section 44 (b) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, and section 3 (1) of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a Solicitor in England who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf; in default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
