Diversion Order, 1957.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 25th day of April, 1957, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land situate in the Parish of Llantysilio.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way running from a point near Tyn Twll, Llantysilio in the County of Denbigh marked "A" on the map annexed to the Order to a point marked "B" thereon to a line running from a point near Tyn Twll aforesaid marked "C" on the said map to a point marked "D" thereon.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Imperial Buildings, Regent Street, Wrexham and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Compensation for depreciation or damage in consequence of the coming into operation of this Order is payable in accordance with Section 46 of the above Act, to which reference should be made.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Under Secretary, Welsh Office, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Cathays Park, Cardiff, before the 12th day of August, 1957, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
