1. It is hereby declared that the Governments of the countries specified in the Schedule to this Order have accepted the Safety Convention.

2. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Safety Convention Countries) (Various) (No. 1) Order, 1957, and shall come into operation upon the date of its publication in the London Gazette.
