The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallant and distinguished services in Malaya:—

#### *Military Cross.*

Captain Peter Frederick WALTER (432312) The Royal Lincolnshire Regiment.

For repeated courage and determination in leading his men in the assault against heavy fire from terrorists in prepared ambush positions. He inspired his men to achieve a moral ascendancy over a numerically superior enemy.

#### *Military Medal.*

2095 Platoon Warrant Officer PISAYI, The Rhodesian African Rifles.

For devotion to duty and personal courage under fire when capturing two Communist Terrorists. The capture of these two men was of great benefit to anti-terrorist operations in the area.

#### *Military Medal.*

21142647 Lance Corporal (acting) MANBAHADUR TAMANG, 7th Gurkha Rifles.

For his skill, tenacity and endurance in ambush operations against Communist Terrorists and for courage during an engagement. It was largely due to this non-commissioned officer's conduct that the terrorist organisation was deprived of two important leaders.
