For courage, persistence and successful leadership during anti-terrorist patrols in mountainous jungle country. His conduct was an inspiration to his men during the boredom of long searches and in action when contact was made.

Military Medal.

21144458 Corporal JITBAHADUR GURUNG, 10th Princess Mary's Own Gurkha Rifles.

For skill and patience in ambush and courage and determination in action. When confronted with a terrorist aiming a loaded double-barrelled gun at his chest, he opened fire, saving himself and his comrades from casualties and killing three terrorists.
