Fishery Byelaws.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Wye River Board intend to apply at the expiration of one calendar month from the date of the publication of this notice for the confirmation by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food for the revocation of Byelaw Number 6 and the substitution therefor of the following Byelaw:—

Byelaw.

Annual Close Season for Salmon—Rod and Line.

The Annual Close Season for salmon fishing with rod and line shall be:

(a) in the River Wye below Llanwrthwl Bridge the period between the 30th day of September and the 26th day of January following, and

(b) in all other waters of the River Wye and in all tributaries of it the period between the 25th day of October and the 26th day of January following.

Any objection to the confirmation of the Byelaw should be made in writing and addressed to the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, 3, Whitehall Place, London, S.W.1, and should be received at that office before the expiration of the period of deposit of the Byelaw. A copy of the objection should also be sent to the undersigned.
