For determination and devotion to duty in the face of personal danger. He was successful in countering subversion and in preventing sabotage by terrorists.

Bar to the Distinguished Service Order.

Lieutenant-Colonel Richard Capel Hanmer MIERS, D.S.O., O.B.E. (58123), The South Wales Borderers.

As Commanding Officer of the 1st Bn. The South Wales Borderers, during a period of ten months spent on operations in the jungle Lieutenant-Colonel MIERS made a valuable contribution to the defeat of the terrorist organization.

He was indefatigable in personally led reconnaissances and in the preparation of successful ambushes.

The success and high reputation achieved by the 1st Bn. The South Wales Borderers is very largely due to the tenacity and courage of its Commanding Officer.

Distinguished Service Order.

Lieutenant-Colonel George Harris LEA, M.B.E. (58116), The Lancashire Fusiliers.

For skill, personal bravery and determination whilst commanding the Special Air Service Regiment during operations against Communist terrorists in Malaya.

He personally directed the operations of his men, was parachuted with them into thick jungle, descended by rope from helicopter aircraft and shared every hazard, danger and discomfort inherent in jungle operations against a ruthless and fanatical enemy.

Military Cross.

Lieutenant Ian Alexander CHRISTIE (443414) The King's Own Scottish Borderers.

For his leadership, personal bravery and determination during a period of eight months in command of a Special Tracking and Intelligence Patrol. He carried out a number of successful operations which produced valuable information and eliminated several terrorists.

Major Arthur Gwynne JONES (156400) The South Wales Borderers.

For gallantry and relentless determination during a period of eighteen months in command of his company in jungle operations. By his personal share in difficult, hazardous and successful operations he set a fine example to those about him.

Captain John Owen LAWES (372331) 2nd King Edward VII's Own Gurkha Rifles (The Sirmoor Rifles).

For leadership, courage and tenacity during months of continuous anti-terrorist operations in the jungle. His tireless example in seeking the enemy and his personal conduct in action against a treacherous foe were an inspiration to the company under his command.

Lieutenant (Q.G.O.) MOTI GURUNG, I.D.S.M. (405966), 6th Gurkha Rifles.

For aggressive courage, dash and determination throughout the operations against terrorists in the jungles of Malaya. Inspired by his conduct his platoon has been markedly successful and achieved the defeat and destruction of their dangerous enemies.

Captain Alexander Lennox Hawkins NAPIER (397999) The South Wales Borderers.

For courage and aggressive determination during a period of eighteen months as the trainer and leader of young soldiers engaged in operations in the jungle. In many actions he reserved for himself the most dangerous roles.
