Office of the High Commission of India.

The High Commissioner for India has with the approval of the Secretary of State for Commonwealth Relations, appointed Mr. A. T. W. Williams, Assistant Superintendent in the Mercantile Marine Office at Tilbury, to superintend the transfer of Lascars or other persons and to grant the Certificate required under section 125 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894 (57 and 58 Vic. Cap. 60).

The fee to be paid for every Lascar or other person in respect of whom such Certificate is applied for, is limited to three shillings each and in no case is the total amount of fees in respect of one crew to exceed five pounds.

EXTINGUISHMENT OF A PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.

City of Plymouth.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of powers conferred upon him by section 23 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, has prepared in draft and proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public right of way over part of the highway at the junction of Adelaide Road and Station Road, Plymouth.

A copy of the draft Order and of a map showing the land over which the right of way proposed to be extinguished subsist may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Pounds House, Peverell, Plymouth, without payment of fee during the usual office hours.
