*The City and County of Bristol (Portway)  
Extinguishment Order, 1957.*

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 13th day of December, 1957, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to extinguish the public right of way from a point on the east side of Portway, at Sneyd Park in the City and County of Bristol, marked "A" on the map contained in the Order to a point marked "B" on the said map where it con-

nects with an existing footpath leading from Portway to the bridge over the Clifton Extension railway near Sneyd Park junction. The said public right of way will be extinguished on the 4th day of January, 1958.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order as confirmed by the Minister has been deposited at the Town Clerk's Office, Room 25, Second Floor, The Council House, College Green, Bristol 1, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays.

The Order becomes operative as from the 31st day of December, 1957, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application to the High Court.

Subject thereto, the Definitive Maps and Statements become operative on the date of the publication of this notice.
