PRESENT,

The **QUEEN's** Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 31st day of January, 1958, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“We, the Church Commissioners, in pursuance of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners (Exchange of Patronage) Act, 1853, and of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners Act, 1860, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for effecting an exchange of the patronage of the benefice of All Saints, Bishopswood, (now vested in the Bishop of Hereford in right of his See) for the patronage of the benefice of Hope Mansell (now vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors and exercised on behalf of Your Majesty by the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being) both of which said

benefices are situated in the diocese of Hereford and we do hereby certify that we have made due enquiry into the respective circumstances and present values of the said benefices and that they are as set forth in the Schedule to the said Scheme.

“**SCHEME.**

“With the consent of the Right Reverend Tom, Bishop of Hereford, and of the Right Honourable David Patrick Maxwell, Viscount Kilmuir, now Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, acting on behalf of Your Majesty, (in testimony whereof they have executed this Scheme) the right of patronage of and presentation to the said benefice of All Saints, Bishopswood, shall be transferred to Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors and be exercisable by the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being on behalf of Your Majesty, and in exchange for the same the right of patronage of and presentation to the benefice of Hope Mansell shall be transferred to and be exercisable by the said Tom as Bishop of Hereford, and his successors in the same See.

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by Her Majesty in Council:

Order in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And Her Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said diocese of Hereford.

WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 24th day of January, 1958, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“We, the Church Commissioners, in pursuance of the Church Patronage Act, 1870, and of the Acts therein mentioned, have prepared the following Scheme for effecting a transfer of the ownership of the interest hereinafter mentioned in the advowson or perpetual right of patronage of and presentation to the churches and cure (hereinafter called ‘the said benefice’) of Dean with Shelton in the County of Bedford and in the diocese of Saint Albans.

“**SCHEME.**

“Whereas we are satisfied that the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Christ and the Blessed Mary the Virgin at Worcester (hereinafter called ‘the said Dean and Chapter’) are entitled to an alternate right of presentation or nomination to the said benefice in case the same were now vacant:

“And whereas the said Dean and Chapter desire to transfer the said interest in the advowson of the said benefice to the Board of Patronage of the diocese of Saint Albans (hereinafter called ‘the said Board’) and are consenting to this Scheme (in testimony whereof they have executed the same):

“And whereas we are satisfied that the transfer will tend to make better provision for the cure of souls:
