RATES OF INTEREST ON LOCAL LOANS.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Public Works Loans Act, 1897 (60 and 61 Vict. c. 51), the Public Works Loans Act, 1935 (26 Geo. 5 & 1 Edw. 8 c. 5), and the Local Authorities Loans Act, 1945 (8 & 9 Geo. 6 c. 18), they have directed by their Minute of the 24th February, 1958, that on loans advanced to Local Authorities from the Local Loans Fund, on and after the 25th February, 1958, there shall be chargeable in lieu of the rates fixed by the Treasury Minute of the 27th September, 1957, the following rates of interest:—
