NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 4th day of March, 1958, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land between New Barn Road and Fawkham Avenue in the parish of Southfleet.

The effect of this Order will be to extinguish the public right-of-way between New Barn Road near New Barn Lodge, and Fawkham Avenue near "Little House", Southfleet.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Council Offices, West Hill, Dartford, and will be open for inspection, free of charge, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on any weekday except Saturdays,

at the above offices until 31st March, 1958, and at White Oak, Swanley, Kent, from 1st April, 1958.

Compensation for depreciation or damage in consequence of the coming into operation of this Order is payable in accordance with section 46 of the above Act, to which reference should be made.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before the 10th day of April, 1958, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
