WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 26th day of February, 1958, in the words and figures following, that is to say:— "We, the Church Commissioners, in pursuance of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners (Exchange of Patronage) Act, 1853, and of the Ecclesiastical Com-missioners Act, 1860, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for effecting an exchange of the alternate right of the patronage of the benefice of Leverton and of a two-thirds interest of the patronage of the benefice of Corringham with Springthorpe (which said interests a two-thirds interest of the patronage of the benefice of Corringham with Springthorpe (which said interests are now vested in the Bishop of Lincoln in right of his See) for the patronage of the benefice of Blyborough and the patronage of the benefice of Withcall (both of which are now vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors, and exercised on behalf of Your Majesty by the Lord High Chan-cellor of Great Britain for the time being), all of

which said benefices are situated in the diocese of Lincoln and we do hereby certify that we have made due inquiry into the respective circumstances and present values of the said benefices and that they are as set forth in the Schedule to the said Scheme.

#### " SCHEME.

"SCHEME. "With the consent of the Right Reverend Kenneth, Bishop of Lincoln, and of the Right Honourable David Patrick Maxwell, Viscount Kilmuir, now Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain (in testimony whereof they have executed this Scheme) the said alternate right of patronage and presentation to the said benefice of Leverton and the said two thirds interest in the right of patronage and presentation to the said benefice of Corringham with Springthorpe shall be transferred to Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors and be exercisable by the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being on behalf of Your Majesty and in exchange for the same the said right of patronage and presentation to the said benefice of Blyborough and the said right of patronage and presentation to the said benefice of Withcall shall be transferred to and be exercisable by the said Kenneth, as Bishop of Lincoln, and his Successors in the same See."
