REGULATIONS MADE IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 13 OF THE ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT, 1931, AMENDING THE EXISTING REGULATIONS.

Regulation 36. With effect from the 1st January, 1959, amend Regulation 36 by the deletion of the words "ten shillings" and the substitution therefor of the words "one pound".

Regulation 37. With effect from the 1st January, 1959, amend Regulation 37—

(1) by the deletion of the words "ten shillings up to December 31st, 1944, and thereafter shall be one pound" and the substitution therefor of the words "thirty shillings";
