The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to approve the award of the British Empire Medal for Gallantry (Military Division) to the undermentioned:—

23086456 Private Jack WILLIAMS, Royal Army Ordnance Corps.

In Tripolitania on the 28th October, 1957, Private WILLIAMS was on fire duty when he saw a United States Air Force aircraft crash in the vicinity of his post.

He immediately drove his fire tender to the scene and fought the fire. He used all his foam extinguishers and, on his own initiative, improvised refills, until the fire was extinguished. He acted with complete disregard for his own safety, ignoring an exploding fuel tank and the hazard of scattered live ammunition.

By his prompt and courageous action he was able to salvage a number of official documents from the aircraft. Private WILLIAMS's personal effort saved the aircraft from becoming a total wreck.
