SCHEDULE.

ALTERATIONS IN THE BYE-LAWS OF THE INSTITUTE OF CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS IN ENGLAND AND WALES REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING ORDER.

(1) Delete existing Bye-law 42 and substitute new Bye-law as follows:—

"42. Each member shall pay to the Institute the annual subscription applicable to him in accordance with the following scale:

Provided that:

(a) For the purposes of this bye-law a member practising both within the Metropolis and elsewhere shall be deemed to be practising within the Metropolis if his principal place of business is within the Metropolis.

(b) Where after the first day of January in any year a member changes his subscription category as set out in the foregoing scale so as to increase the amount of the subscription applicable to him him he shall pay for that year any additional subscription necessary to increase his subscription to the amount then applicable to him; except that where the said change takes place after the last day of June one-half only of the said additional subscription shall be payable.

(c) Where a person is admitted to membership after the last day of June in any year he shall pay one-half only of the subscription otherwise applicable to him for that year.

(d) Where after the first day of January in any year a member changes his subscription category as set out in the foregoing scale so as to reduce the amount of the subscription applicable to him no reduction of the subscription shall be made for that year except as provided in (e) below.

(e) Where a fellow gives notice to the Council of his desire to cease to be a fellow and become an associate and such notice is received by the Council not later than the 31st January in any year he shall pay for that year the subscription applicable to him in accordance with the foregoing scale as an associate; but if the said notice is received after the 31st January in any year the member shall pay for that year the subscription applicable to him as a fellow.

(f) Any member who has exercised and not revoked the option provided by Clause 3 (d) of the Scheme of Integration referred to in clause 34 of the supplemental Charter shall for the purposes of this bye-law 42 be regarded as an incorporated accountant member F.S.A.A. for so long as he is not entitled to describe himself as a chartered accountant."

(2) Delete existing Bye-law 44 and substitute new Bye-law as follows:—

"44. All annual subscriptions payable under these bye-laws shall be due and payable on the first day of January in each year or, in the case of members admitted after that date, on the date of admission; and all additional subscriptions provided for in bye-law 42 shall be due and payable on the date on which the change in subscription category referred to in proviso (b) of bye-law 42 becomes effective."
