BOROUGH OF OSWESTRY

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Oswestry have made application to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for the issue of an Order under Section 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partly to repeal alter or amend the Oswestry Markets and Fairs Act, 1848, the Oswestry (Corporation) Water and Markets Act, 1885, and the Oswestry Corporation Act, 1939, so as:—

(1) to confer upon the Corporation further powers to alter the places at which any of their markets may be held, to hold new markets and to provide buildings for the purposes of any of their markets:

(2) to extend the powers of the Corporation relating to the development of land:

(3) to make of general application the powers of the Corporation with respect to the making of loans for the erection of buildings:

(4) to enable the Corporation to seek powers for the compulsory acquisition of land for the purposes of their markets undertaking:

(5) to authorise the Corporation to borrow money for these purposes:

(6) to remove restrictions as to the siting of markets and as to the area of land to be held for certain purposes:

And whereas a copy of a draft of the Order which the Corporation have asked the Minister to issue may be inspected at the Guild Hall, Oswestry, during office hours before Thursday, 16th October, 1958.

Notice is hereby given that E. L. Everatt, Esq., O.B.E., M.I.C.E., having been duly appointed by the Minister will attend at the Guild Hall, Oswestry, on Thursday, 16th October, 1958, at ten o'clock in the forenoon to hold a local inquiry into the subject matter of the application and that any person interested may attend at such inquiry and be heard with reference to the application.
