*Road Traffic Act, 1930—Section 46*

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th August 1958, the Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation made the "Trunk Road (Holyhead Road, Upper Bangor) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1958," which will come into operation on 8th September 1958.
