BOROUGH OF HENDON

The Borough of Hendon Smoke Control (No. 1) Order, 1958

Notice is hereby given that the Hendon Borough Council in the exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 3rd day of September 1958, made an Order entitled the Borough of Hendon Smoke Control (No. 1) Order, 1958, declaring the area described in the schedule below to be a smoke control area. The Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map to which it refers may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, The Burroughs, Hendon, N.W.4, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 19th day of September 1958.

Within that period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

From a point in Stonegrove, Edgware, opposite to the north-west boundary of Lonsdale Close, Orchard Drive, the boundary of the area runs northward along Stonegrove, Brockley Hill and Elstree Hill South and eastward along Barnet Road coinciding with the boundary of the Borough of Hendon as far
