

as the northern end of Edgwarebury Lane. Thence the boundary of the area runs southward along the western edge of Edgwarebury Lane as far as the northern end of Edgwarebury Park to which it turns and then runs southwards and westwards coinciding with the south-eastern limits of Edgwarebury Park as far as Edgware Way.

Thence the boundary proceeds westwards across Edgware Way, passes along the rear boundaries of Nos. 102-112 Hillside Gardens and turns south along the east side of Green Lane as far as the northern flank of No. 145 Green Lane to which it turns. From the rear of that property the boundary runs south-south-eastwards along the rear fences of Nos. 145-123 Green Lane as far as the south-eastern corner of No. 30 Kings Drive. There the boundary turns along the south flank of that property and continues westwards to Stonegrove along the rear boundaries of the even-numbered properties in Orchard Drive.

The boundary of the area is defined and is shown more particularly by the map referred to in the Order.
