NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

Borough of Southgate (Wades Hill Footpath) Diversion Order, 1958

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by section 44 (5) of the above Act, after consultation with the Southgate Borough Council, proposes to make an Order for the diversion of a footpath at Wades Hill, Southgate, in the County of Middlesex.

The draft Order relates to land situate in the North-East Ward of the Borough.

The effect of the Order will be to divert part of the public right of way running from Wades Hill to Houndsden Road to a line running from a point 3 feet north of the existing right of way in Wades Hill, varying to a maximum of 12 feet northwards of the existing right of way, and rejoining it at a point 65 feet west of Wades Hill.

A copy of the draft Order and of a map contained in the Order have been deposited at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, London N.13, and at the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall London S.W.1, and will be open for inspection free of charge during normal office hours.
