THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT, 1868

THE GOVERNING BODY OF RUGBY SCHOOL having on the 26th day of February 1959, in virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the above-named Act, made a Statute in the terms appended hereto amending the existing Statutes of the said School, the said Statute is hereby published in the *London Gazette* in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in the said Act.

And Notice is hereby given, that any person, body of persons, or body corporate, authorized in that behalf by the said Act, may, within two months after the publication of this notification, petition Her Majesty in Council to withhold Her approval from the whole or any part of the said Statute.

STATUTE AMENDING THE STATUTES OF RUGBY SCHOOL
MADE BY THE GOVERNING BODY ON THE 26TH DAY
OF FEBRUARY 1959.

"Resolved:

(1) That Statute XXII be amended by the deletion of the figure '£100' and the substitution therefor of the figure '£250', so that the first sentence of the said Statute shall in future read as follows:

'No Scholarship shall be of the value of less than £40 a year nor of more than £250 a year;'

(2) That the Seal of the Governing Body be affixed to a copy of the preceding Resolution and to any other documents required for submission to the Privy Council, and that the Clerk make application to the Privy Council for the approval of the said amendment."

TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office, at the Bank of England, on Friday, the 13th March 1959, at 1 p.m., for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, the National Debt Act, 1889, and the National Loans Act, 1939, to the amount of £230,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000 or £100,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday, the 16th March 1959, to Saturday, the 21st March 1959, inclusive and will be due 91 days after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated, and the net amount per cent. (being an even multiple of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.
